A NEW LIFE IN CHRIST

Receiving Jesus Christ as your personal Saviour is the beginning of an eternal relationship, giving you amazing potential for an exciting life here on earth and in heaven.

1. ETERNAL LIFE IS KNOWING GOD PERSONALLY

“Now this is eternal life: that they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent.” John 17:3

“**Eternal Life**” is more than just a long life; it is a whole new life - the type of life that God has, with no limitations of any kind. God's love is not limited to the worth or loveliness of the person or persons being loved.

John 3:16 says, *“For God so loved the world, that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.”*

Likewise, He is not limited in His patience, kindness and forgiveness or in any other way.

To have “**Eternal Life**” means that you have the opportunity to live a full and meaningful life.
